



# Old Napi Card Game Directions

**You need 2-8 players and an Old Napi deck of cards.**

**There should be 20 cards:** 2 of each animal and one Old Napi card.

**Shuffle the cards.** You may want to mix a pile of cards around on the table with your hands for about a minute.

**Deal ALL of the cards to all of the players.** Some players may end up with one card more than others.

**Remove the pairs of animals in your hand.** Place each pair face-up in front of you. If you have three of the same card, remove two and keep the other in your hand.

**The dealer will hold out his/her cards face down** to the player on the left.

**Let the player pick a card** from the dealer's hand. If the card makes a pair with any of your current cards, you should put the pair of animals down in front of you. If not, put the card in your hand.

**Offer your cards, face down to the person on your left** to match pairs also. Keep going until there is one card left. Go around the circle until the last pair has been made.

**The person holding the Old Napi card (which has no pair) loses;** everyone else wins!
